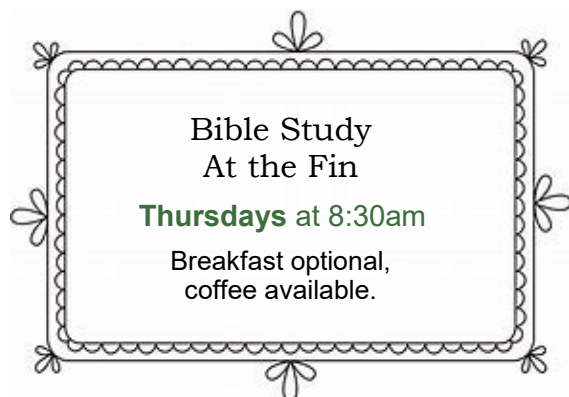

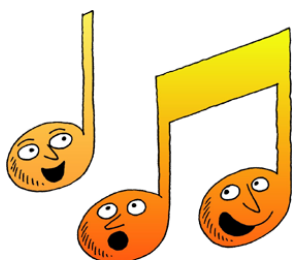


Are you shopping for your kids/ grandkids for back to school items?!?

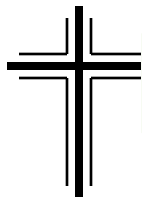


Sabbatical update

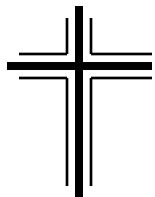

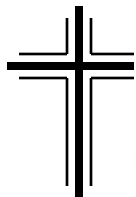
