Dear God, As we journey down this Advent road, grant us the courage to make peace. Peace in our hearts, Peace in our homes, Peace in our communities. Amen.


Joy

"We strongly encourage anyone and everyone to go through this class if they get the chance as it will benefit everyone in some way, regardless of their age or economic status. We are so happy that we decided to go through this program and know that one day we will be debt free."

We had a fun, informative, and productive 9-week course. We learned about the 7 Baby Steps as well as how to protect our financial assets with insurance, investments, real-estate and giving. Everyone, regardless of his/her own financial situation, learned something valuable and was able to apply the information immediately.




Did you ever wonder how the coffee cups, plates, plasticware, creamers, etc arrive Lord of the Lakes?
