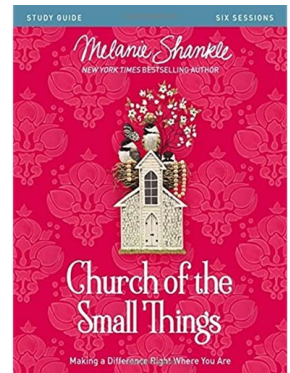
## Fellowship Meal
